




With Room 12 & Room 18

Uniform Update

Next year, in response to community feedback and the implementation of the Year 7 students to High School, Governing Council have decided to make some changes to the school uniform policy at Coorara. The proposed changes are:

There will now be a **black zip up windcheater jacket with the school logo** on it as well as our existing red windcheater. This will be available for purchase from the school.

Students in Reception to Year 4 will wear the red with black trim polo top. Students in Years 5 – 7 will wear black with red trim polo top. In 2021 Year 5s will be able to wear either polo top while we transition to the new policy.

To support families to purchase the new black jackets, they will be available in **Term 1, 2021 for \$20.00** (regular price will be \$33.00). There will be a limit of **1 jacket per student** at the special introductory price.



Students will only be able to wear a red school windcheater or a black school windcheater jacket from the beginning of 2021.
