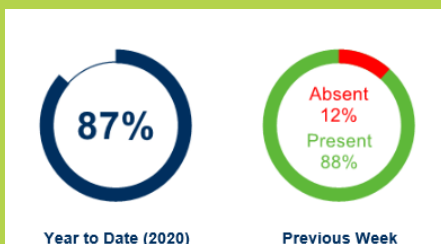

Remembrance Day

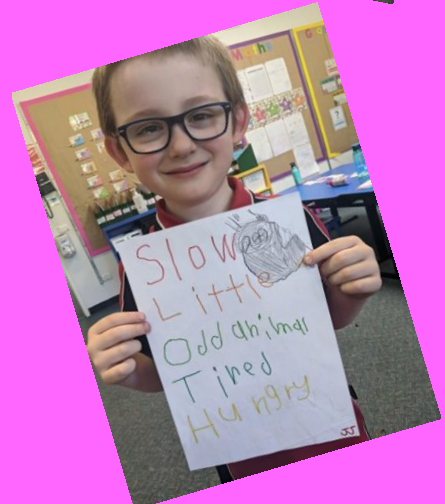
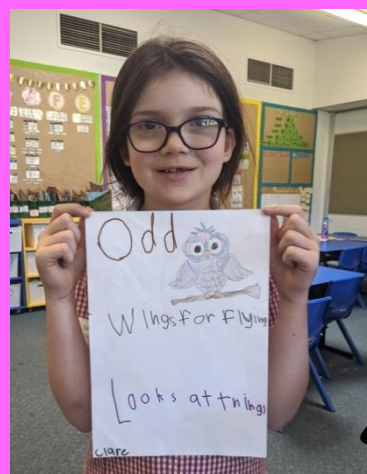
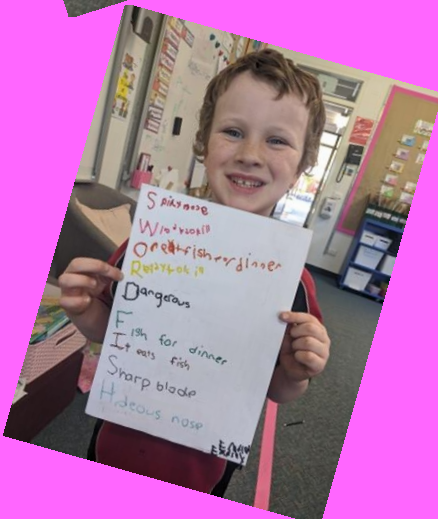
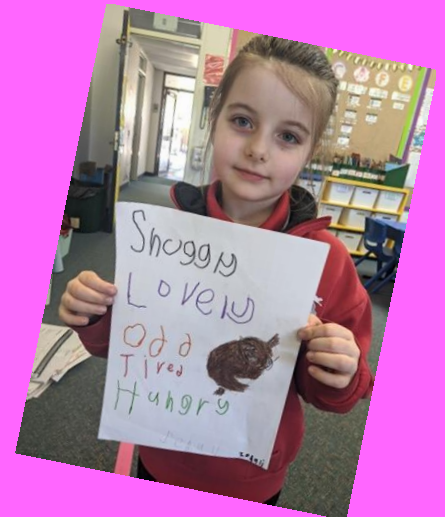
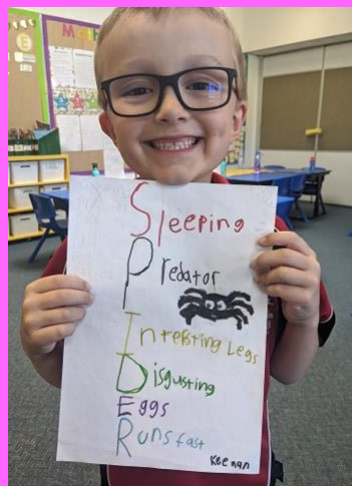
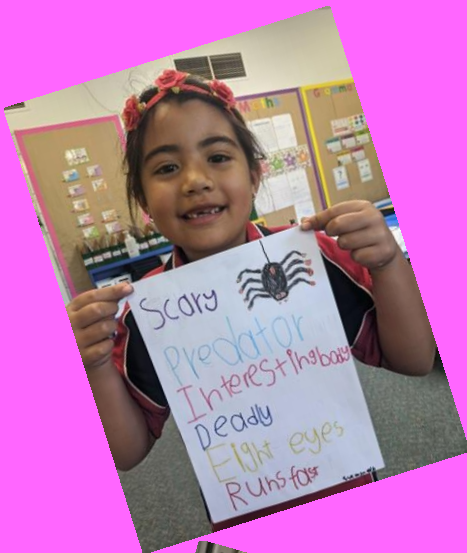

Have you met the Coorara chooks?

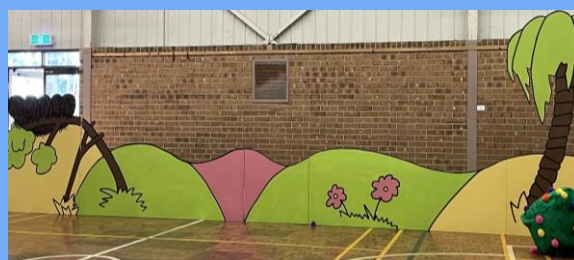
We have 8 chickens that feel alone at the weekends.
