# Message from the Principal - Steph Tulloch

Not long, and we will be painting the school multi-coloured. Well maybe just the children and staff! The **COLOUR EXPLOSION** is happening next Friday from 11:30 am this will be so much fun. Our fantastic fundraising team have organised a BBQ lunch for children and parents on the day. Place your orders in by Monday, 23 September. During the lunch break there will be family activities to do, and a staff vs. senior's netball game. (I better find my knee and ankle braces!!)

All children can run in the Colour Explosion. Glasses and headbands are for students who have raised over \$5. Children eligible for prizes must have raised over \$10 for the school. So far, we have raised \$7,679 to go towards the new senior playground. Let's see if we can break the \$10K mark.

**Senior Playground revamp:** Our playground is 21 years of age now, and is in need of a revamp, and to fix components that no longer meet the latest safety standards codes. We have designs coming to us from 'Forpark Australia'. The design will hopefully be available for you to see in Term 4.

**Enrolments:** Coorara Primary is open for enrolments for 2025 and 2026. If you do not have your enrolment forms in, or you know families that want to come to Coorara and have not yet enrolled, please collect an enrolment pack from the front office.

Ready for Reception: Our reception transition programme will commence in Term 4. This is for all children enrolled to start Reception in Term 1, 2025. Please be aware we are not zoned to a kindergarten or suburb and can accept most enrolments. Information about the programme will be coming out next week.

**OSHC Vacation Care:** The OSHC vacation care program is out, and available online through the OSHC website. There are copies in the front office. Please make sure you get your booking in quickly as spaces are filling fast.

**Festival of Music:** This fabulous event was held on Tuesday night. It was a magical night and as always, blew us away with talent, colour, and entertainment. Thank you to all parents who attended.
